We understand that getting a doctor's appointment after school is very difficult. If you are concerned about your child's health / sickness / not feeling well, then please come and see her.

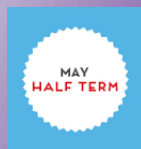
**\* Cash Payments**
