* New Entrance System

To ensure we keep children safe we now have an intercom and video camera on the school's main door. Please press the button and Mrs Sneary will answer. Say who you are, your child's name or which member of staff you are here to see.

When exiting the building there is a button up to the left of the door. Again this will ensure that children never exit the building without an adult.

When bringing your child to school please ensure that you use the correct entrance for your child's class. Teachers are always keen to get learning started so please leave your child promptly.

If your child is late and you are using the main entrance please ensure you use the pedestrian gate and do not walk through the car park. This will make sure our children remain safe.

* School Nurse Drop in session

We would just like to remind you that the school nurse will be in school on:-

Tuesday 12th September at 2.00pm - 3.30pm. We understand that getting a doctor's appointment after school is very difficult. If you are concerned about your child's health / sickness / not feeling well, then please come and see her.



* Hospital appointments:

Reminder: If your child has a hospital appointment, you must give the school at least 24 hours' notice, to ensure a medical mark is recorded otherwise your child will be given an unauthorised mark. Please show the office your child's appointment letter, so we can make sure that it's logged onto our school system.

Reminder: Please make sure that your child's P.E kit is in school at all times. They must have the following items a Rookery t-shirt black/ blue shorts and Black trainers or pumps.



* School Meals

Please note all dinner monies should be paid at the beginning of each week.
